

Dear St. Anthony Mission Families and Friends,

In an ongoing effort to slow the advance of COVID-19, Bishop Guglielmone has made a series of guidelines for parishes to follow. Please see the [bishop's letter to the faithful](#).

For St. Anthony Mission this means:

- There will be no 9 am Mass and adoration on Thursday, and no Stations of the Cross on Friday.
- All normally scheduled formation classes, choir practices, etc. are suspended until further notice.
- St. Gregory the Great will have two priests celebrate the 8:30am Mass each weekday. That Mass will not be open to our parishioners, but it will be livestreamed so that you can join in prayer. Please go to www.sgg.cc and click on the Mass Live Stream button.
- The Chapel will be open for quiet, solitary prayer. Sanitizing wipes will be provided for those who choose to come to the church to pray to enable to you to wipe the pew where you pray. Please be sure to keep distance between you and anyone else in the church.
- St. Gregory the Great Sunday Mass will be celebrated at 11:00am in English and 1:00pm in Spanish without participants, but will be livestreamed (www.sgg.cc - Mass Live Stream). You can also watch Mass at EWTN (see schedule at [//www.ewtn.com/tv/schedule](http://www.ewtn.com/tv/schedule)).
- The parish office will be closed, however, Karen will continue to work remotely. Please feel free to call or email her with anything we can do to assist you.
